- h. **Sports News:** Costs for school participation in extra-curricular sports events have increased significantly in price this year. Cost is calculated by a base cost of \$2 per student (total population) plus an additional cost of \$50 per division/gender of pod sports, per sport eg Volleyball is now an extra \$50 for the boys and an extra \$50 for the girls; the same for intermediates. End of last year, balance was -\$10,000; put the cost back onto each school. Cost won't be put onto families, will be coming out of school funds eg pizza day income.
 - Junior Boys and Girls Volleyball Pod Tournaments are happening next week on October 8 & 9 at SMOS
 - Cross Country meet is on October 16 at Erindale Park, 40 students have signed up.

 j. School Initiatives: initiatives are based on our Catholic School Improvement Learning Cycle supported by 5 pillars – Believe, Excel, Respect, Thrive and Trust

Believe:

- Classes assigned as Spiritual Leaders for the School morning announcements; liturgies and masses
- Daily Affirmations
- Mindfulness Mondays ~ Christian Meditation Teachers will be provided meditation tools for their classroom.

Excel:

- Literacy ~ Reading Focus continue developing new teaching strategies to be in line with the science of reading and the new curriculum expectations; focus on reading strategies
- Math Curriculum Focus on Assessment – looking at math curriculum and making sure assessments are balanced

Respect:

- Equity ~ Ensuring every student is visible in the curriculum; working to remove old stereotypes from Library resources and purchase new, better materials.
 Note to parents: we can accept donations if books are in good condition; nothing before year 2000
- Uplifting Indigenous Education and enhancing education surrounding antiblack racism including racial slurs – we are seeing an uptick of inappropriate language use - age appropriate conversations in the classroom, teachers are addressing it; if there is intent, there are progressive discipline measures. K to gr 3 cannot be suspended but can serve in-office suspensions; Gr 4-8 there can be suspensions
- This past week was Truth and Reconciliation Week and today is Orange Shirt Day National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. Truth and Reconciliation Week is a national program open to all schools across Canada. Learning topics included the contributions of Indigenous peoples, the history of Residential Schools, treaties and what learners and educators can do to take action toward reconciliation. You will notice that students all tied an orange ribbon on the fence to demonstrate our commitment to learning about Indigenous education and working towards reconciliation. Two members of Indigenous dept worked with Gr 5-8 students in Gym gym sized map of Canada, demonstrated all of the different groups of indigenous people, and where they reside. Will come back later in year
